PHASE 1 MARSEILLE

28th FEBRUARY – 5th MARCH 2012

Training course 1



A Training Course aiming to introduce the topic of Education to Sustainable Development. ESD is not only about sustainable development but is, firstly, education. Through activities run by trainers of CEMEA del Mezzogiorno, two of the pillars of ESD, **cultural diversity** and **gender equality**, are introduced, thanks

also to the contribution of external facilitator that will present methods related to forum theatre and furthermore, as **pedagogical path**, implemented on the topic of sustainable development.

PHASE 2 LOCALLY

MARCH – APRIL – MAY 2012

ESD Tool Fair



During the first Training Course a commitment to the participants will be requested. The participants will be asked to organize, at local level an event (also a **one day lasting** or **2 evenings** will be good solutions) that is involving **local organizations** working on the promotion of one or more of the 8 ESD pillars, introduced during the training course. The organizations will **share** with the other

guests one of their own tool for learning. The local tool fair will not only represent a **peer to peer education** process but also the chance for the two participants to the long term training course to choose one tool, in order to translate it into English and to be **presented** on an **international** level during the next step of the project (TC2).

PHASE 3 PAU

30th MAY – 5th JUNE 2012

Training course 2



The second Training Course will be lead by the same CEMEA del Mezzogiorno team of trainers but, this time, some activities are going to be run directly by the participants themselves. In fact they will introduce and experience the use the internationalized tools chosen from the local tool fair. In this way we will start to create the elements composing the ESD Toolbox.

This training, furthermore, will also focus on the other ESD topics chosen: **responsible consumption**, **health promotion**, which seem more relevant to our European society. Also in this occasion external contributors and visits of pedagogical path will be integrated in the program.

PHASE 4 PAU

8th – 13th OCTOBER 2012

Seminar and international tool fair



At the **final seminar 2 participants** to the proposed training courses and **3 representatives of the local organizations** involved in the local tool fairs will take part. The seminar, structured as an international tool fair, will be an opportunity to share **some more tools** experienced during the local tool fairs and to enlarge the number of the ones that will be uploaded on the common tool box

on ESD. At the same time **1 representative** from each international partner of the OPEN network will meet beside the seminar, to **evaluate** the reached **outcomes** from different points of view and they will prepare the possible **future actions** of the new **ESD multipliers** within a local and international strategy about ESD.

PARTICIPANTS to OPEN

The participants that will join to the whole training process, will be chosen by the different organization on a local level, 2 participant for each organization, aiming to select those youngsters that are interested in what has been identified as a Long Term Training Course (LTTTC) about the Education on Sustainable Development, and willing to join all the different steps, including the local one, and to contribute in future national and international actions that will eventually originate from OPEN.
